




CHUCK MUND - KINNELON



LAUNCHING — The Wayne Skyhawks 4-H Club did some launching recently through township skies. Chuck Mund of Kinnelon (upper left) mounts his rocket model onto a launching platform. Powered by three "super-powered" D-type rocket engines, his six-foot model has flown as high as one-half mile. George Wagner of Wayne (lower left) attaches power clips to his Omega rocket which is launched electrically from 15-feet away. The rocket also holds a movie camera in the nose section. A launch control system is shown above, while ignition and lift-off of Mike Gortych's rocket is captured (at right). The Wayne youth's rocket can easily achieve an altitude of 1,600 feet. Wagner and his brother Jerold (bottom right) retrieve a rocket after its flight.


